Want to be a Good Recycler?



Use this checklist to improve and expand on your recycling opportunities!
When it comes to curbside recycling, less is more.

Get Started Curbside:	
	Empty recycling out of plastic bags and place loosely in carts or dumpsters.
	Recycle plastic jugs, such as detergent and milk jugs.
	Recycle boxes from packages, shoes, cereal, pantry, Kleenex.
	Recycle empty bottles from food/beverages such as: soda, water, ketchup, wine and beer.
	Recycle laundry and bath containers from shampoo, lotion, detergents, and soap.
	Recycle clean plastic dairy tubs from yogurt, cream cheese and sour cream containers.
	Get multiple recycle bins to place in different locations; kitchen, laundry, and basement.
Reduction:	
	Create a backyard compost bin for food recycling at home.
	Contact a local shipping service to see if they will take used Styrofoam peanuts and blocks.
	Bring lunch in reusable containers.
	Carry a reusable coffee cup in your vehicle. Ask the barista to fill it vs. a new one every time.
	Sign up for TerraCycle for school specific materials like crayons and Capri Sun pouches.
	Subscribe or opt into a "stop junk mail" service.
	Carry a reusable water bottle, cultery, and straw and use them.
Getting Greener:	
	Separate plastic bags labeled #2 & 4 and bring them to the grocery store to recycle.
	Put plastic cups, clamshells, and frozen food contains into the trash.
	Donate clothes, shoes, and accessories to local thrift stores for reuse.
	Drop off batteries, light bulbs, anti-freeze, and paint at local drop off recycling center.
	Sign-up for GSI's Yardwaste Service.
	Bring bulky metals to a drop-off recycle center.
